

# ST. LADISLAUS ROSARY SOCIETY MEETING

## Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 11:15 a.m. by Julia Pochinski, President. Julia welcomed everyone and led the opening prayer "Our Lady of Good Counsel."

**Secretary's Report:** Julie Mieska read the minutes from the January 17, 2010 meeting. Elaine Bunczak moved to approve the minutes as read. Marlene Cherek seconded. Motion carried. Julie mentioned that the revisions to the Rosary Society Group List have been made, and copies will be distributed to officers and group leaders.

**Treasurer's Report:** The January 18, 2010 to March 21, 2010 Financial Statement prepared by Kay Miller, Treasurer, was reviewed. The report was accepted and approved as presented.

**Rosary Society Scholarship Recipient:** It was announced that Chelsea Ostrowski, daughter of Roger and Pam Ostrowski, has been awarded the 2010 Rosary Society Scholarship of \$200.00. Appreciation was expressed to Geraldine Furmanek for coordinating the scholarship application process.

**Lenten Soup Supper:** Julia reminded everyone that the Rosary Society will host the Lenten Soup Supper on Wednesday, March 31. Adeline Domask will make chicken soup and sandwiches. A sign-up sheet for helpers and desserts was passed around, and then placed in the church entrance.

**Senior Citizen Bingo:** Julia shared the following schedule for Senior Citizen Bingo's that will be hosted by the Rosary Society in 2010: August (Group 2); September (Group 3); October (Group 4); November (Group 5); and December (Group 6). Group leaders can decide (conferring with Sister Mary Ellen on available dates) when to hold the Bingo, and then notify Julia of the date chosen.

**May Rosary Devotions:** Rosary Society members will lead the May Rosary Devotions on Tuesday, May 25. Coffee and dessert will be served after the service.

That amount had not yet been determined, however, Sister Mary Ellen will post the amount when it's available. Income for the Valentine Raffle (\$611.50) and Cherry Tree (\$433.75) were listed in the Treasurer's Report.

Julie Mieska shared a request from a Rosary Society member to announce that a fund raiser for Jessica Stanislawski is being held that afternoon (Sunday, March 21) at the 4H Building at the Rosholt Fair Park. Jessica is 14 years old and is battling Lymphoma for the third time. Members were encouraged to attend and help Jessica and her family during this difficult time.

Sister Mary Ellen announced that a Spaghetti Dinner fundraiser will be held for Brock Cherek on Sunday, April 1<sup>st</sup>. Brock, a little boy who nearly drowned, needs much medical attention as he struggles to recover from his accident.
